TULSA, Okla. (May 9, 2013) – The Tulsa Chapter of Executive Women International® (EWI) held its annual scholarship banquet on May 9, 2013, at the Doubletree Hotel Downtown. Executive Women International Scholarship Program (EWISP)

EWISP is an annual, competition based program. High school seniors are nominated by their schools to participate in the competition. Judges select winning students based on scholastic achievement, leadership qualities, good citizenship, extra-curricular activities, and financial need. EWI of Tulsa awards five scholarships: (1) \$5,000, (1) \$3,000, (1) \$2,000, and (2) \$1,000.
